Tremendous Results in 2016 HKDSE



Hoi Ping's statistics have been on the rise since the first HKDSE. In 2016, they soared to an unprecedented height: compared to 2012, there was a 10% increase in the number of students obtaining level 5 or above, and a 15% increase in level 4 or above. 92% have attained the general university entrance requirement (33222), and 74% received a JUPAS offer.

Among the high achievers this year, a special mention should be given to the following students. Gifted in languages, So Wing Yi (6A) obtained two 5** in Chinese and English, which is a remarkable achievement. Ko Kit Yan from Class 6D displayed the spirit of a fighter. Diagnosed with systemic lupus erythematosus (also simply known as lupus), she was absent from some school days and the entire mock exam; not giving up, Ko invested her utmost effort in studies while fighting with illness. In the HKDSE, she sat all exams and obtained satisfactory results: one level 5*, two level 5 and one level 4.
