Learning through Experiencing – Visit to Hong Kong UNESCO Global Geopark

On 2nd and 16th December 2017, 25 Geography students visited Hong Kong UNESCO Global Geopark which is dedicated to promote landform and rock conservation among citizens. The tour began at the High Island Reservoir east dam where magnificent giant columnar rocks dominate the landscape. Our students were surprised to see the staggered hexagonal volcanic rock columns formed about 140 million years ago at close range. Walking along the trail, students had the opportunity to see hands-on coastal management strategies adopted at the site to protect the coast. One of the highlights of the tour was the visit to the lookout area near the cliff where students could see different coastal erosional features and experience the force of wave erosion up close. The visit to the Geopark was full of amazement, achieving its aims in sparking our students' interest in appreciating the wonder of nature and understanding tectonic movements of Hong Kong in the ancient times.
