



### Maintaining Excellent Standards in HKDSE 2021

Results of the HKDSE 2021 were released on 21 July 2021. With their diligence and academic competence, Hoi Ping students achieved impressive results despite challenges posed by COVID-19.

Of the 125 students who sat the HKDSE this year, 91.2% attained the university entrance minimum requirement (33222), which is our second-best performance since 2012. Hoi Ping's performance in the four core subjects surpassed the territory-wide statistics by a wide margin. There were 27.1% and 69.9% of students who achieved Level 5+ and Level 4+ respectively, and 3.1% of them achieved Level 5\*\*.

Like before, our S6 students have achieved encouraging results that will definitely inspire the successive cohorts!

Upon graduation, Terry received the University of Oxford Croucher Scholarship to read for his doctoral degree in Organic Chemistry at Oxford.

## Hoi Ping Representative in International Biology Olympiad

5B Yau Ho Hin obtained the Bronze Prize at the International Biology Olympiad - Hong Kong Contest 2020, which was co-organised by the Education Bureau and the Hong Kong Academy for Gifted Education. The contest aims at promoting biology education in Hong Kong and providing enriching opportunities for students with potential. The winners go through training to represent Hong Kong at the International Biology Olympiad held overseas. The prize-giving ceremony was held on 27th November 2020. Yau Ho Hin successfully captured a place amongst the top students, which is a remarkable feat!

## Hong Kong Secondary Schools Debating Competition – Grand Final Championship

In the first term of the previous academic year (2020-2021), the English Debate Team won both of the two term rounds as well as the Term 1 Championship of the Hong Kong Secondary Schools Debating Competition. In the second term, the team won the two rounds of the term again, and proceeded to the Grand Final in August this year.

With weeks of research and intensive practice, this team of diligent and eloquent debaters eventually won this final debate of the year; and was crowned the Champion in the 2020-2021 Grand Final (Kowloon and New Territories Middle Division I).
